

JOYCE GIBSON: 24 MAY 1922 - 9 JUNE 2020

I have been asked say a few words about my aunt. She was born, as were her 3 older brothers, at Hobbits in Nether Westcote, just opposite the Chapel. The house at that time was called "The Firs". After attending the village school Aunty became a pupil teacher. Then she helped on the farm - I don't know how much as she is said to have been "delicate". At some point the family moved to Hill Farm and then to Field Farm. I can just remember my parents having two rooms and living side by side with my grandparents and aunt. After my grandmother died, my grandfather and aunt moved along to Well House, then known as Fairview.

Very few people in Westcote now remember A.J (Aunty Joyce), as she and my grandfather moved to Stow in 1965. She very rarely returned. She attended the Baptist Church in Stow until several years ago when, unless taken in a wheelchair, she just couldn't get there. Aunty was a spinster, so I became her assistant and have done shopping, banking and odd jobs for about 25 years. For the last 5 years she has lived at Abbeyfield House, where she has been very happy and contented. They and I will miss her.

It was her wish to be buried at Westcote, so I am grateful to the PCC for allowing that to happen and to Rev Dr Stephen Blake for conducting the graveside service.
